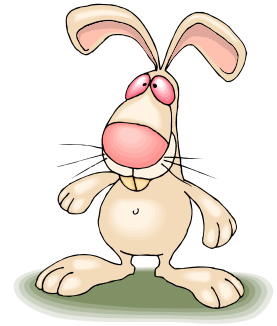


Name that Rabbit?

Number correct:

1 to 3: Not bad. A few more carrots, a wiggle of your nose, and you’ll be hopping along with the big bunnies in no time.

4 to 6: Good job! You sure know your rabbits from a hole in the ground.

7 or 8: Fantastic! You’re leaps and bounds ahead of the rest.

9 or 10: Who's the bunny? You're the bunny!

Congratulations! Now that you have successfully answered one...or all...of the questions, choose a famous rabbit from the questions above (or another one you can think of) and do the following fun activities.

Surf the Net! How is a “real” rabbit different than a “cartoon” rabbit? Navigate through cyberspace to get your answers. Perform a search of both real rabbits and the famous rabbit you chose. Then compare and contrast their physical characteristics, what they eat, where they live, and what they physically are capable of doing. Dig into a Good Book! Read books or visit websites to find out about the use of rabbits who are part of holiday traditions such as the Easter Rabbit.
